9. Bill Clinton lied to the American public about his relationship with Monica Lewinsky; therefore, he probably lied to the American public about Iraq, too.

2. I've been to at least twenty Disney movies in my lifetime, and not one of them has been especially violent. I guess the Disney people just don't make violent movies.
3. Most of my professors wear glasses; it's a good bet most professors everywhere do the same.
- ▲ 4. Seems like the Christmas decorations go up a little earlier each year. I bet next year they're up by Halloween.
5. The conservatives I've met dislike Colin Powell. Based on that, I'd say most conservatives feel the same way.
